    - iii. Next, select the Student subscription plan.
    - iv. Complete checkout by filling in basic information about yourself and selecting the Student role type. If you already have an Autodesk account and you didn't already sign in, you will be prompted to sign in before continuing.
    - v. Provide the following address for the institution address: 1 Market, Ste. 400, San Francisco, CA 94105 USA.
    - vi. Select University/Post-Secondary as the institution type.
    - vii. Select Autodesk University as the institution.
    - viii. Add the URL: autodesk.com
    - ix. Add the graduation date of 06/2025.
    - x. After all sections of the checkout form are completed, click Submit.
    - xi. Once your account information is submitted, email strategic.partnership.support@autodesk.com

      - 2. Description: Please approve education access for First Robotic account [email]
    - xii. Once the account has been approved, request the desired product(s) from the <u>Education Get Products page</u>.
